- Overcoming resistance to change



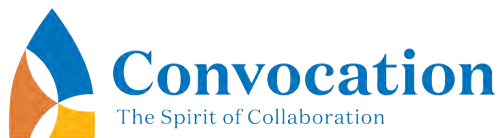
