## Steps to Initiate FEMA:

- 1 On March 13, 2020, the President declared a National Emergency related to the coronavirus pandemic. With this, he triggered assistance under FEMA Public Assistance, Category B “Emergency Protective Measures”
- 2 To be eligible, you must apply for FEMA assistance before the deadline of April 12, 2020. ([See link below.](#))
- 3 The official “recipient” of FEMA funding is YOUR state, territorial or tribal government. They are responsible for receiving the funding and distributing to approved “subrecipients” (your entity).
- 4 Your contact at your state, territorial or tribal government is their Office of Homeland Security/emergency management agency. Click on this link to locate your specific emergency management agency in order to apply: <https://www.fema.gov/emergency-management-agencies>. They are responsible for receiving the funding and distributing to approved “subrecipients” (your entity).
- 5 We suggest that your entity apply for benefits, even though your eligible expenses may not yet be known.
